

John Wesley, wrote in 1786, "I am not afraid that the people called Methodists should ever cease to exist in Europe or America. But I am afraid, lest they should only exist as a dead sect, having the form of religion without the power"



- Everyone is a disciple of something
- What are we disciples of?
- Disciple is translated from Greek to mean learner or student
- The reason our Churches exist is to make Disciples
- We been making Church Members and Not Disciples

- We can be a good A.M.E. and not be a Disciple of Jesus
- If we are a Disciple of Jesus, we will be a good A.M.E.
- Discipleship helps us to see we must be disciplined by others
- We can't be discipled and ultimately transformed ALONE



Transformation occurs when a Disciple is in an interdependent posture, we must rebuke individualism, rather than celebrate it

 Discipleship must emulate the relationship Jesus had with the Disciples

They were together in Community

- Discipleship is a communion, a relationship
- Community is commanded in the Bible, it is not optional
- Our Faith is not private, that's contrary to God's Word
- God designed transformation to happen in community
 - Acts

- Ekklesia in Greek, means called out ones. Called to Jesus out of the world and placed in community
- We live out our faith in an environment of relationships
- Discipleship is more than information and behavioral modification

Matthew 26:20-26

- Judas admits he was never transformed
- He never calls LORD, but Rabbi
- He never surrendered his life to Jesus, Jesus was not LORD
- Judas spent time with Jesus & learned from Jesus, informed by Jesus but was never transformed

Discipleship is

- Following Jesus
- Finding and Fishing for people to make them disciples
- Doing it in fellowship with others

Spiritual Disciplines

- Prayer 1 Chronicles 14:13-17
 - The continuing work of setting our hears on God
- Meditation Mark 10:17-23
 - Read to let God speak to you
- Fasting Matthew 4:1-11
 - We must be weaned from depending upon ourselves to become dependent upon God alone
- Service John 13:35
 - The grace of humility is worked into our lives through service

Spiritual Disciplines

- Simplicity Philippians 4:11
 - We spend our lives conjugating 3 verbs, to want, to have and to do
- Surrender Mark 8:34-35
 - Releasing our grip on all of it
- Solitude Mark 1:21-39
 - Turning toward God

Spiritual Disciplines

- Are we ready to ask ourselves some hard questions?
 - What's working?
 - O What must we continue doing?
 - What's not working?
 - What must we stop doing?
- Is our church inward or outward focused?

- Are we willing to do ministry out of imagination and not out of memory?
- Are we willing to be just as creative and innovative as our ancestors were to meet the needs of our people?
 - Free African Society
 - Colleges, Universities and Seminaries
 - Benevolent Societies

- The pervasive trend in our churches today is to be a Christian without ever becoming a disciple of Jesus that is, a "student," or "learner."
- The desire for maintaining the status quo frequently outweighs the desire to be obedient, faithful followers of Jesus
- Are we trying to preserve our church for ourselves and our generation?
- Are we trying to do church in a way that reaches out to a new generation?
